
We have updated the Safety Protocols as follows:

- 1. **Cloth or surgical face masks** covering the nose and mouth are **required** for everyone aged 3 and older in the balcony, when moving, and when unable to maintain 6-feet social distancing inside the building. While seated in the lower sanctuary, you may take off your mask.
- 2. Please maintain social distancing throughout the time you are in the building and in the pews.
- 3. Pre-registration continues to be necessary for contact tracing. Please sign up using this link: https://forms.gle/KKHMWBTa1Ptk2HZs7. - 4. Please self-screen for symptoms or close contact with a known positive case and worship from home if you have them.
