

Sunday Worship Safety Protocols

- 1. **Cloth or surgical face masks** covering the nose and mouth are **required** for everyone aged 3 and older in the balcony, when moving, and when unable to maintain 6-ft. social distancing inside the building. While seated in the lower sanctuary, you may take off your mask.
- 2. Please maintain social distancing throughout the time you are in the building and in the pews.
- 3. Pre-registration continues to be necessary for contact tracing. Please sign up using this link: https://forms.gle/KKHMWBTa1Ptk2HZs7. You can also sign up by clicking on the picture in the Weekly Update or by going to our website. If you do not pre-register, please register with the usher when you enter.
- 4. Please self-screen for symptoms or close contact with a known positive case and follow the latest CDC guidance on guarantine requirements.
- 5. If you test positive and determine that you were contagious when you attended worship, please let the office know so we may notify close contacts.

On March 13, we will change our protocol to be mask optional in all areas except the balcony and reduce our social distancing requirements.
