# March 2022 Newsletter

#### **From Pastor Michael**

"If, however, you bite and devour one another, take care that you are not consumed by one another." Galatians 5:15

The United Methodist Church has been in the news again, and our continuing public battle seems to warrant discussion. If you haven't read, the General Conference that was supposed to meet in 2020 has been pushed back again to 2024, effectively cancelling it altogether, since they would normally meet in 2024 (every 4 years). The General Conference is comprised of clergy and lay representatives elected from each Annual Conference around the United States, as well representatives of the Central Conferences in foreign countries. They meet to determine the contents of the Book of Discipline, which guides the governance and organization of our church. They have pushed it back because the African delegates cannot get visas in a timely manner to attend.

This decision is disappointing to everyone. Those seeking LGBTQ+ inclusion in the full life of the church feel that justice is again delayed. Those clergy and churches seeking to leave the UMC to end the conflict and debate over this issue and begin a new denomination are also frustrated. The path to churches and clergy leaving the denomination with money and land is unclear without the General Conference to pass new legislation. Currently, if a church leaves, they forfeit their money and property to their Annual Conference. However, it seems that the leaders of the traditional/conservative churches are finally willing to take that risk and break away to form a new denomination, the Global Methodist Church. They have stated that they will start this organization/denomination in May this year.

So, for us at St. Paul, there will be no immediate effect. We are still a part of the UMC, and there is no official path to split or leave. Our church has no official position on the issues at hand and among our people there is a wide difference in theological position on marriage, ordination, and holy living for LGBTQ+ people. It is very likely that several of the most conservative churches in our state will seek to leave the UMC for the GMC. It is probable that this will result in a messy, litigious break. No matter what happens, our witness to the one Body of Jesus Christ will be damaged. Please be in prayer for our bishop and leaders, the churches that are breaking away, and the pastors, church members, and LGBTQ+ people often caught in the middle.

### **Sunday Worship Safety Protocols**

We have updated the Safety Protocols as follows:


